• **How it Came to Be (SAFC Funding Presentation referenced)**


- Athletic Department Fee Proposal
 - Student Benefits Package was created as part of the approval of the \$50/semester mandatory athletics fee (BOR approved fee starting Spring 2011)
 - SAFC resulted as the designee to allocate the 8% (~\$4) of the Athletic Fee that would return to students
- Constitution
 - The SAFC constitution was shared with incoming members along with the founding

documents and BOR memos establishing athletic fee/SAFC


- Benefits Package
 - Includes SAFC \$4/student portion of the fee to be used to enhance student life/ campus experience as well as enhance student experience athletic events.
 - Student section at all ticketed home games and reserved no-cost student tickets available on a first come first serve basis.
- Indirect vs Direct Funding
 - Direct - Manoa Maniacs sub-committee responsible for direct funding/ programming towards SAFC mission (free food at games for students, prizes, giveaways, etc)
 - Indirect – Grants SAFC provides to enhance the campus experience/life.
- **Officers**
 - SAFC will have a Chair, Vice-Chair, Treasurer, and Secretary
 - Nominations/Elections will be held at a subsequent meeting with more members
- **Goals**
 - Grants- no funding for Fall 2013, possibly resume for Spring 2014, funding dependent.
 - Infrastructure items- Clarify budgets with committee, reconcile financials. Work with Manoa Maniacs about purpose and budget items.
 - Website- currently utilizing Weebly, will delegate responsibility with election of officers
 - Student Family Tickets and Seating- Will restart discussion with athletics about tickets for family members next to student, possibly student section access for guests. Carl Clap and Student Attendance Meeting a possible outlet for discussion.
 - Facilities Access- Will restart discussion with VC for Students office about increased athletic field/pool access. Pilot program was conducting in Spring 2013, inquire about Fall 2013 funding for access.

CHRONOLOGY of EVENTS

FY 2011 - after BOR adopted student athletic fee 07/10/2010, year long negotiations between Athletics & CSO student leaders facilitated by VC Hernandez

- Resulted in "Student Benefits Package" and creation of Student Athletic Fee Committee

CHRONOLOGY - cont'd

- Students get designated seating and free admission to athletic games
- 8% of \$50 (i.e. \$4) provided to a Student Athletic Fee Committee (SAFC) to determine use for student activities that enhance student experience/campus life AND that enhance student experience at athletic events

CHRONOLOGY - cont'd

- Constitution of SAFC developed, refining purpose and use of the \$4 portion of the \$50 fee, (9 CSO student members)
- Group engaged in both direct programming and indirect programming to fulfill purpose and use of \$4 portion

Created for programming

CHRONOLOGY - cont'd

FY 2013 - initiating a sub-committee of SAFC called Manoa Maniacs to assume programming function of SAFC

- 12 students, 3 each from programming boards in Student Life (Activities Council & Recreational Sports Programming Council), the Student Athlete Advisory Committee (SAAC) and Resident Hall Association (RHA)

CHRONOLOGY – cont'd

- Manoa Maniacs will do direct programming to enhance student experience at athletic events and to enhance students' competitive and athletic experiences
- SAFC will retain responsibility for conducting grant funding program

PROGRAMS FUNDED – cont'd

- **INDIRECT GRANTS 2011**
 - 8 Recreational/Leisure (\$8,225)
 - 1 Athletic Event (\$6,500)
 - 2 Competitive Experience (\$11,000)
 - 15 Campus Life (\$27,754)

PROGRAMS FUNDED – cont'd

- **INDIRECT GRANTS 2012**
(17/35 programs funded for \$19,044)
- Categories Changed to meet different needs
 - 7 Recreational/Leisure (\$3519)
 - 4 Health and Wellness(\$6400)
 - 1 Athletic Related(\$2500)
 - 1 At athletic Events(\$3500)
 - 4 Other (\$3125)
